# Connect with God through Visual Art

First United Methodist Church

Visual art was an extremely important component of early Christian spirituality. Unfortunately, those of us in the Protestant tradition moved away from engagement of visual art in nurturing spiritual growth to using the spoken or written word predominantly. Pastor Mark Barden's work in his doctoral program will focus on visual art and how it can help one deepen one's spiritual relationship with God. To provide a basis for his dissertation, he is offering a short-term course, "Connecting with God through Visual Art," in three different congregational settings. The first congregation offered this opportunity is Elkin FUMC.

The course begins with an afternoon/early evening miniretreat on Sunday, May 28, 3-8 pm at the church focusing on our being co-creators with God. Topic sessions will be held Tuesday, May 30, 6-8:30 pm (Role of Visual Art in Christianity); Thursday, June 1, 6-8:30 pm (Aesthetics and Concepts of Beauty); Sunday, June 4, 2-4:30 pm (Spiritual Disciplines Using Visual Art); Tuesday, June 6, 6-8:30 pm (Creating Art in an Atmosphere of Prayer); and Thursday, June 8, 6-8:30 pm (Incorporating the Discipline of Artistic Expression into One's Spiritual Life). A closing day-long retreat will be held Saturday, June 17.

In addition to the topical presentation, each gathering will include a significant time for experiential engagement with visual art as individuals and as a group. This interactive experience will utilize multiple techniques to help individuals connect with God spiritually.

Persons interested in participating do not need to possess artistic talent, only a desire to learn and openness to experiment. Participants need to plan attending all sessions including the mini-retreat and day-long retreat. This is important to the research taking place through these experiences.

There is no cost for the course or the meals that will be served each time. Basic art supplies will be provided. The only "cost" is attendance at each session.
